Our holiday home (family-owned since 1092 and home to four generations) is intended to be your home away from home. We hope you'll feel at home with us. We hope you'll find everything you need for a pleasant stay. The following house rules are intended to help ensure a harmonious stay. We have also listed a few rules that we hope you'll understand. By treating the holiday home properly, you will help us provide satisfactory accommodations for you and future guests.



## **FIRST OF ALL**

If you're missing any furnishings or need any assistance, please feel free to contact us at the phone numbers provided. We'll take care of it as quickly as possible. If you have any complaints, please also contact us immediately and give us the opportunity to resolve them. A negative review afterward won't make your stay more pleasant, nor will it help us! We always strive to help you!

## **PARKING SPACES**

Please park your vehicles in a row as close to the neighboring house as possible (in a row, one behind the other) so that our vehicles also have space and a clear lane remains for entry and exit. At least four vehicles can be parked in a row in the gravel yard. This saves us unnecessary maneuvering. The parking spaces across the street are NOT public parking spaces and may NOT be used.

## **PETS**

Pets are welcome in our holiday apartment. However, we ask you to follow a few rules: 1) Bring suitable sleeping accommodations for your pets (blankets, baskets).

2) Please also place a mat (blanket, towel, etc.) on the couch.

5) The garden is NOT a dog toilet. Should your four-legged friend do so in the garden, we expect you  
to clean up properly.

## **GARDEN**

The garden (behind the wooden fence to the next wooden fence) is for communal use. The garden features a patio with seating, a charcoal grill, and a fire pit. Seat cushions can be found in the gray box in the garden. For the fire pit, use the wood in the upper right corner of the garden.

## **NIGHT'S REST**

In the interest of continued good neighborliness, we ask that you respect the quiet hours between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. (especially in front of the front door and in the garden). Of course, you can continue listening to music at a moderate volume, watching TV, laughing, and even dancing indoors with the windows closed. Barbecues and campfires in the garden must also be stopped by 10 p.m.

## **VALUABLES**

As landlords, we are not liable for tenants' valuables. Please lock the door to your apartment when you are away and at night. You can leave the front door open.

## **WASTE SEPARATION**

We separate residual waste (trash can in the kitchen), recyclables (yellow bag in the kitchen), and paper and glass (gray bin in the kitchen). A biowaste bin is located in the garden. A residual waste and paper bin are located in front of the garage on the left.

## **SMOKE**

Out of consideration for future guests, smoking is strictly prohibited in the holiday apartment. Smoking is permitted outdoors (in front of the front door and in the garden). Please use the ashtrays provided and do not simply throw your cigarette butts on the ground.

## **BAD**

One bath towel is provided per person per stay. This will be on your bed upon arrival. We ask that you dry the glass shower walls with the provided squeegee after use.

Please do not dispose of sanitary waste or food scraps in the restrooms. Trash cans are provided in the bathroom and kitchen for this purpose.

## **INTERNET**

During your stay, our guest Wi-Fi is available. Please note that your internet activity will be tracked via your IP address, and illegal downloads or page views will be reported.

## **HEATING AND FIREPLACE**

The holiday apartment is heated by central heating. The thermostats are easy to operate using the + and - buttons. The middle "Boost" button ensures rapid heating. The wood-burning stove provides cozy warmth during your stay. Firewood can be found behind the garage on the left. Please read the wood-burning stove's operating instructions carefully BEFORE use. The wood-burning stove is NOT intended for storage of any kind!

## **DAMAGE**

No one intentionally damages property or furnishings. However, it can happen to anyone that something breaks. If any damage occurs, we ask that you notify us BEFORE your departure.

## **DUTY OF CARE**

In winter, it is not permitted to leave windows open for several hours while the heating is on. The radiators are automatically switched off when windows are open, causing the rooms to cool down. However, daily ventilation for approximately 10 minutes is expressly recommended.

Windows and doors must be closed when leaving the holiday apartment for an extended period. Damage caused by rain and storms is the responsibility of the tenant if these conditions are not met!

## **KEY**

Make sure you have your keys with you when you leave the apartment!

When you leave, please put the keys back in the key safe and change the combination.

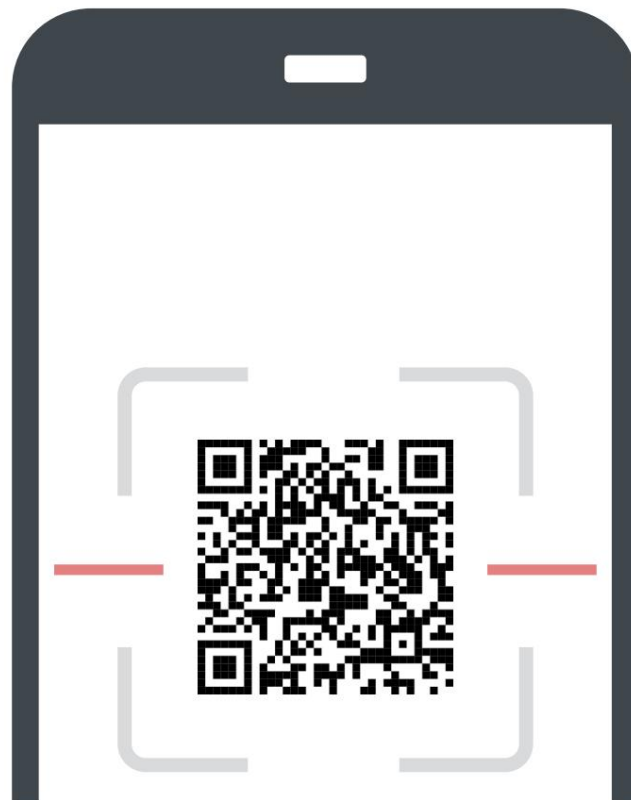
